Organisation purpose:	We Belong exists to ensure young migrants living in the UK are treated equally and fairly in the society they call home. We Belong works with and for young migrants to hold those in power to account and fight for wider immigration reform.  We do this by breaking down barriers through direct advocacy, strategic litigation, campaigning, and equipping young migrants to be leaders and set agendas within the migration sector. We also provide support by giving accurate information on student finance rules and various opportunities and make referrals to organisations for young people to get the legal advice they need.			
Context	We Belong team is comprised of eight staff members based in London and Manchester. The team works with young people who have migrated to the UK and supports young people who are impacted by hostile immigration policies and empowers young people to speak out and be inquisitive about their rights. In 2021, after four years of campaigning, we secured a major policy win on the Ten-Year Route to settlement: this win will benefit the estimated 330,000 children and young people living in the UK with precarious status.			
Role purpose:	Our Communications Officer will engage and mobilise young migrants and empower young people to share their stories in a purposeful manner. The Communications Officer will work closely with staff to identify, support, and develop creative content to raise awareness of the organisation and our projects, in both London and Manchester. The Communication Officer will develop organisational narrative and have oversight of all comms elements of organisational events. The Communications Officer will engage with external stakeholders to develop creative means of marketing We Belong's social justice campaigns. The Communications Officer will be working closely with our Comms Consultant to advance We Belong's campaigns and advocacy.
